

# SELLING TRANSFORMERS

In order to sell a transformer, we need to ensure we follow the points below

1. If it is built in Australia prior to 1979 it may contain PCB's and cannot be sold
2. If it was imported into Australia prior to 1986 it may contain PCB's and cannot be sold
3. If the transformer is as described in points 1 or 2 it cannot be sold even if it is emptied of oil. An empty transformer is still regarded as contaminated
4. If the transformer has a Nata Approved certificate stating it has less than 1 part per million, they can be sold regardless of production or import age. This certificate must be attached to the sale description as proof of compliance.
